and projects. Programs that the Madison/Guilford Jaycees have offered include:

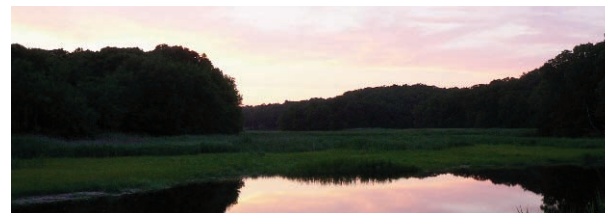
